When we read previously that he left his fishing boat to follow Jesus, we can safely assume that he left much more than that. He had a family and we hear in this gospel of Jesus healing Peter's mother-in-law. Also, the gospel helps us recognize the need Jesus had to be away from the crowds and confusion to take time to pray and become revitalized and strengthened for his ministry.

### Catholics and Cremation

Cremation has been acceptable for Catholics since 1963. There are two possible options. One: Cremation takes place after the Funeral Mass, with burial of the cremated remains at a later date. Two: Cremation takes place beforehand and the cremated remains are brought to the church for the Funeral Mass. Burial of the ashes takes place after Mass.

### Candles burning bright

When people enter a Catholic Church they expect to see ranks of burning candles. St. Peter's Cathedral is no exception to the rule. We have votive candles at the Shrine of Our Lady, St. Joseph and St. Peter. The word "votive" comes from the Latin word "vota" or gift. Each lighted candle represents our prayer which burns in the presence of God.
